- Winter publication printed; Almost all have been distributed

- Only 1 table sold so far

Scholarship – Julie White & Cindy Rodriguez

- Have received 11 freshmen applications
- School will email seniors regarding senior application and incoming freshmen about deadline

- Need to modify website details regarding t-shirt scholarship - now logo design scholarship
- Deadline for all scholarships is March 31

Athletic director report – Bob Lee

- Approached by Mr. DeFabio about pilot program for a spirit cap - no cost to school; could be marketed by school, Parents Association, WPBC; sold for \$25 and some money would come back to school; WPBC could purchase caps for \$12.50 for giveaways and use WPBC logo on cap; brand is his own brand (high school hats)
